Report of the President Tuairisc an Uachtarán Megan Reilly

Key Points Since Previous Council (21st January):

Menlo Rent increases:

Menlo came out with an unexpected rent increase of €1400 so we acted quickly. It's unfortunate that almost a year on from Cuirt Shakedown we are facing into a similar situation with one of our student villages. This is down to the legislation not being passed fast enough to apply the rent caps to student accommodation, so that is where we have focussed our efforts. I have done a lot of media since the press release came out, and have contacted the Minister for Housing regarding why it has taken so long to get the legislation on rent caps enacted. This will be further discussed at council.

<u>Levy:</u>

I met with the Bursar and was quite clear that we want something about the levy to change. She has committed to investigating the Aras na mac leinn fund portion of the levy and to look for an agreement on the 5% interest. I have requested an update on this from her before Council.

<u>Éalú</u>

Everything is nearly good to go on this, we just need to ensure we have funding secured. I have requested that the President give the go ahead for funding. I will be convening the Entertainments committee soon and will also provide an update on this at council
