Report of the President Tuarascail an Uachtarán *Clare Austick*

Details of Work Undertaken from the 10th of February to the 2nd of March:

Solidarity Gathering

Organised a solidarity gathering for one of our students who has been issued with a deportation order. We are waiting to hear back from the Department of Justice and Equality.

4% Rent Increase in On-Campus Student Accommodation

- 1) Press Release & Media we issued a press release expressing our frustration and anger at the University's decision to increase the rent by the maximum allowable increase percentage under the Rent Pressure Zone Legislation. I was on Galway Bay FM, Shannonside FM, News Talk, iRadio, Community Radio Castlebar, Connemara Radio and gave quotes for articles in the Connacht Tribune etc to get our message out on as many channels as possible.
- 2) Met with President Myself and the two VP's met with the President immediately after the news broke. A few action points followed from that meeting. A joint letter from the President and myself has been sent to the board of directors of Atalia Ltd stating our disappointment and requesting a meeting with the board. We will likely be meeting the week of the 9th March. We decided to change the student launch of the strategic plan to a forum for students to air their concerns and speak about their own experience.
- **3)** Student Forum Approximately, 30 students attended and spoke about how the 4% rent increase will affect them.
- 4) Petition We launch an online petition asking Atalia Ltd to revoke their decision to increase the rent by 4 %. A few part-timers also went around Goldcrest and Corrib Village gathering signatures in person. We have around 2000 signatures in total.
- **5)** Academic Council Brought it up at Academic Council and had our stance minuted. Many staff members were in support.

- 6) Sent Letter to all Udarás members and made a few phone calls The Vice President for Education and myself sent a letter to all governors of the University asking them to support us when we ask Udarás to formally take a stance and issue a statement requesting for the board of Atalia Ltd to revoke their decision to increase the rent.
- 7) **Protest** Planned and coordinated the protest in the Quad which was on at the same time as Udarás.

Details of Work Undertaken from the 10th of February to the 2nd of March:

Student Survey

A lot of my work over the past 3 weeks has been in promoting and talking to students about the student Survey. I was around campus in different locations from 12-2pm most of the days the survey was open. We achieved 38% response rate which is the highest response rate in all the Universities and 1% higher than last year.

Inclusive Learning and Teaching

We have been working away with interviewing students about their education experience on campus. We hosted a lunch and survey event for Postgraduate students and are currently in the process of organising a symposium for June.

Meeting with the President

After the news broke that our on campus accommodation was set to increase in price by 4% we immediately called a meeting with the president to discuss how this happened and how we could reverse it. We pointed out how this will affect our students and their families, and how this is not in line with the new University Strategy. The president then agreed to attend a revised type of event where students could voice their concerns and have their experiences heard. I wrote with the SU President a letter to all members of our governing authority and intend to raise the issue at the Governing Authority meeting on February 27th.

Student Digital Pathways

I have been working with the SDP team on ensuring that the student voice is heard throughout the consultation process of the new student records system, which I will update reps on at SU Council on March 2nd.

Open Textbook Event

Myself and the SU Council Chairperson have been working the the College of Science, Engineering and Informatics as well as the library in developing an Open Textbook event for April of this academic year. Open Education is the concept of having accessible and free access to education materials, the event will look at the current student experience (including financial barriers, lack of copies of books available in the library etc.), how this works in practice and supports the library can offer in finding resources and changing course content.

Congress Motions

Worked with Class Reps and the Executive on compiling themes for motions. Wrote 3 motions to go to USI Congress in April around PG Supports, International Student Finance, and Sex work decrimialisation. Helped our Clubs captain write a motion on student sport Ireland. Working to create an application form for Congress 2020.

- SHAG Week: SHAG Week was a huge success this year, we had a great variety of events and lots of different stands and workshops happening throughout the week. I would like to extend my thanks to USI, the HSE, the NWCI and Sexual Health West for coming down on Wednesday. I would also like to thank the Student Health Unit Staff for all of their help and for running STI Screenings for the week!
- Student Death: It is very sad to say that we had a student death last week. Nicole Collison who was a student in the CALPD here in NUI Galway sadly passed on the 21st of February. The President and I along with other staff members attended the funeral in Athlone to offer our sincerest condolences to the family and friends of Nicole.
- Drug and Alcohol Awareness: Met with the REACT Committee to organize a few events around drug and alcohol awareness The events will be happening in the last week of March. These include a panel discussion with some great guests with lots of insight into the area!
- Rent Increases: We were outraged to hear the news that the on campus student accommodations would be increasing their rents by the maximum allowed by legislation, along with 5 other universities in Ireland. We called for a meeting the the University President and discussed the issue and came to a few arrangements, including changing the student launch of the strategic plan to a town hall with the President where students could openly voice their concerns directly with him. We also planned a protest to coincide with the next meeting of the University Management Team as well as drafting them all individual letters. We will be meeting the board who approved this increase in the coming weeks and hope to seek clarity on how they came to said decision with a goal to ultimately reverse the 4% increase.
- Marchathon: Marchathon is running from the 2nd to the 27th of March. This is a great way to get your steps up and promote a healthy lifestyle. There are lunchtime walks organised once a week for the duration of the month, one of which the SU will be leading. This will be a fun way to get active but also a good social outlet.

- IT STOPS NOW: On the 5th of March we will be doing a stunt in support of the IT STOPS NOW Campaign. This is a campaign to end tolerance of gender based violence. We will have a banner up on campus in an area with high footfall and lots of posters up too.

- Sexual Experiences Survey: We will be pushing the survey from the 2nd to the 15th of March. This survey is very important as a lobbying tool for more funding and resources around sexual health, in particular the area of rape and sexual violence. A survey like this has not been done for many years and it is so important that we have up to date data on these issues. This survey also gives students the option to give feedback on their experience in reporting an incident of rape or sexual assault. This is absolutely invaluable as it will allow institutions to create and further develop their policies around sexual harassment.
