

The meeting was opened and standing orders were adopted. The external speakers were accepted.

A presentation was given by the sustainability office. A question was put noting the University's commitment to the SDGs, asking how that is congruent with the University refusing to pay PhDs minimum wage, given the SDG for no poverty.

A question was asked about the sustainability of the university's energy.

A question was put regarding the environmental impact of AI. The need for a University AI policy was noted.

The Welfare and Equality Officer asked about having more electric car charging points and if it would take away from other parking.

A presentation was given from AMLÉ President Bryan O'Mahony. He highlighted Pink Training and their gambling survey. Discussion around the ESU was had, as was discussion around decriminalising sex work.

A question about minutes for Comhairle Náisiúnta was put, and it was explained that the AMLÉ website is being updated. A question about PhD stipends was asked.

Officer reports were given and accepted. The President was asked if they were raising the issue of Technion with the President and it was explained that they were. A question about SIN's Editor was asked to the President and it was explained that the new Editor would be announced shortly. A question was asked about under the bridge for college Christmas and the Welfare and Equality Officer responded noting plans to mitigate risks. The Education Officer was asked if he was consulted on the cancelling of reading weeks. He responded that neither he, nor anyone in the SU, was consulted, and that he is working on seeing its return. The Leas-Uachtarán do Ghaeilge was asked why there isn't services through Irish available in Sult, and it was explained that there isn't enough staff with Irish, but she is working on it.
